

Checkers Netball Club Player Code of Conduct

As a representative of Checkers Netball Club you are expected to abide by the following Code of Conduct:

- I will respect the rights, dignity and worth of all participants and coaches regardless of gender, ability, cultural background or religion and I will not do or say anything to threaten their well-being or safety.
- I will play fairly within the rules as set by the International Federation of Netball and will set a good example in my sporting conduct, attitude and behavior upholding the name of Checkers Netball Club.
- I will respect umpires and match officials at all times, accept their decisions are final and will not talk back, or make any non-verbal gestures towards them during the match or display negative body language.
- If issues arise on court with another player, match official or umpire, I will seek out my captain or coach first, so that they can seek clarification and resolution.
- I will respect equipment owned by the club and the facilities they use, as well as those of other clubs.
- I will keep to agreed timings for training and matches and inform the coach/captain if I am going to be late or unable to attend.
- Should my availability change due to unplanned circumstances I will give my captain/coach the maximum notice possible.
- I will pay league and tournament fees on time.
- I will not use bad language or make derogatory comments towards any other player, match official or umpire.
- I will adhere to selection decisions made by the coach/captain.
- I will adhere to the club uniform requirements (when advised to do so by the coach/captain).

Failure to adhere to any of the above will result in an investigation and potential disciplinary action as determined by the Checkers Executive Committee.
